

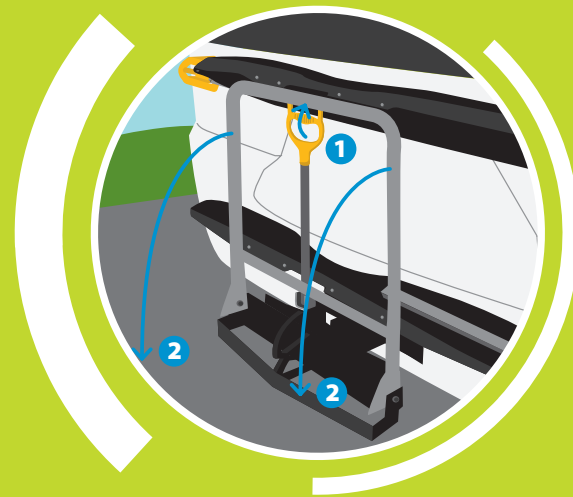


# HOW TO USE A BIKE RACK

Please remember **loading and unloading your bike is your responsibility**. Always load or unload your bike from the front of the bike rack.

## More information

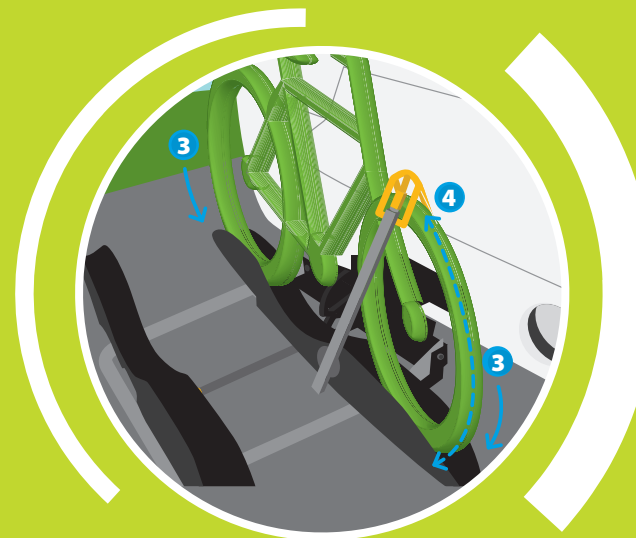
- The bike racks can carry two bikes at any one time
- Usage is on a first come first served basis
- The bike racks are designed to carry bikes with wheels larger than 16" in diameter
- Bikes are insured for a maximum of \$1500 while on the rack
- Loading/unloading the bike is the responsibility of the cyclist/passenger
- Before loading your bike remove any loose items that could fall off while the bus is moving i.e. clothing, drink bottle
- Always load/unload your bike from the kerbside, do not stand in the line of traffic
- If you experience any problems when using the bike racks please inform the driver immediately
- Horizons Regional Council accepts no responsibility for any damage caused to bikes



## Loading your bike

Advise the driver that you are going to load your bike.

- 1 SQUEEZE**  
Squeeze bike rack handle up to release
- 2 LOWER**  
Lower the rack until horizontal
- 3 LOAD**  
Lift bike onto rack with front wheel facing toward yellow support arm, fit wheels into clearly labelled slots
- 4 SECURE**  
Raise support arm over front tyre so the hook rests on top of the front wheel.



## Unloading your bike

Advise the driver that you are going to unload your bike.

- RELEASE (REVERSE OF 4)**  
Unhook and lower support arm from front tyre and lift your bike from the rack.
- UNLOAD & RAISE (REVERSE OF 1)**  
If no-one else is using the rack, squeeze handle and fold bike rack back up.

## Fare information

Horizons Regional Council and Uzabus take no responsibility for damaged or lost cards and credit balances cannot be transferred. Your initial GoCard costs \$12, with \$5 of travel already loaded and all new/replacement cards have a one-off \$7 administration fee. You can top up your card with cash on the bus or by cash or EFTPOS at the Uzabus office (minimum top-up \$10). Please keep your receipt and check the amount loaded is correct.

GoCard is a pre-paid travel card that entitles you to cheaper fares and saves you from worrying about having the correct change.

**SuperGold Card**  
School-aged, under 5's travel free: Current High School ID required if not in school uniform. Card holders travel free from 9am to 3pm weekdays and anytime weekends and public holidays.

**Student**  
Tertiary or Polytechnic student, current ID must be provided.

**Community**  
Beneficiaries and people with disabilities. Current Community Services Card must be provided. Fares are subject to change. Please visit [www.horizons.govt.nz](http://www.horizons.govt.nz) for up-to-date information.
