

Don Linklater Memorial Bursary 2019 Application Form

To honour the contribution made to the Region and to local government by the late Don Linklater, Horizons Chairman 1989-2000, we are offering a bursary for university study.

The Bursary is worth \$3,000 per year for up to three years, and aims to support students studying in areas relevant to our work.

To be eligible you must:

(please read this section carefully)

- be studying, or planning to study, at a New Zealand university fulltime in 2019 at either under-graduate or post-graduate level (internally, extramurally) in one of the existing fields:
 - Resource Management
 - Environmental Planning
 - Environmental Engineering and Modelling with particular emphasis on river and drainage basin dynamics.
- be a New Zealand Citizen or Permanent Resident and live in Horizons' Region (although you may be studying elsewhere in New Zealand).

How is the Bursary awarded?

The Bursary recipient will be selected by a panel of Horizons representatives. Short-listed applicants will then meet with the selection panel.

What you need to do to apply:

If you meet the eligibility criteria and would like to apply for a Bursary, please complete this form and attach:

- verified copies of your most recent academic qualifications. If you have not yet completed a term of university study, please attach your previous two years' high school academic records. If you have already completed some tertiary study please attach academic transcripts for study completed to date;
- an essay, of no more than 300 words, telling us why you should receive this Bursary, and what you intend to do as a result of your study that will benefit our Region and environment; and
- a copy of your CV (optional).

Applications must be received no later than 8am, Friday 4th April 2019





Bursary Conditions

Applications for the Don Linklater Memorial Bursary are sought annually, and may be awarded for up to three years. The Bursary will be awarded, subject to funding, and providing applications are of sufficient merit.

A Bursary will be awarded to the successful candidate under the following conditions:

- a total of \$3,000 per year will be paid in two installments, one payment in February/March and one in August;
- proof of satisfactory academic progress must be provided to Horizons following completion of each semester;
- if the successful candidate continues to meet the criteria each semester, they may receive the Bursary for up to three years;
- Bursary recipients are required to apply for the Linklater Bursary at the beginning of each academic year for approval;
- Bursary recipients, who, without good reason, withdraw from full-time study or fail to successfully complete papers, may be required to reimburse all or part of the Bursary to Horizons.
