# SELF HELP MONITORING & RESPONSE GROUPS (SHMRG)

#### **OPERATIONAL RESPONSE PLAN**

#### PURPOSE OF SELF HELP MONITORING/RESPONSE GROUP (SHMRG)

The Self Help Monitoring and Response Group is an informal group of community minded farmers who have volunteered to monitor river levels and LMS flood protection infrastructure during major flood events; to communicate information to Horizons Regional Council (HRC); and to respond with practical measures as directed.

#### **ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

Members of the SHMRG have volunteered to monitor pre-allocated sections of stopbank and associated flood protection infrastructure once alerted by HRC staff at a pre-determined river level. Maps and schedules included in this document show the section of river allocated to each of the SHMRG sub-group leaders and identify the key people available to assist in monitoring those respective sections. Sub-group leaders are expected to communicate information on flood levels and stopbank condition and performance to Horizons Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).

The role of the leader of each sub-group is to:

- 1. Receive requests from the EOC to initiate monitoring.
- 2. Establish rosters, communicate with team members and co-ordinate monitoring of the allocated section of river on a 24hr basis.
- 3. Periodically report to the Operations Manager in the EOC on the condition and performance of flood protection works.
- 4. Initiate sand bagging operations on own initiative where there is a risk of localised over-topping.
- 5. Access materials from scheduled depots and utilize farm machinery to assist with loading out and transport of materials.
- 6. Be cognisant of the safety and welfare of team members.

No other physical response measure should be undertaken without the approval of, or clear direction from, the EOC Operations Manager.

Membership of the SHMRG attaches no responsibility for the adverse effects of flooding that might arise irrespective of the members' efforts. Members are community-minded individuals who appreciate that local communities may have to stand alone during major flood events and have volunteered accordingly to be part of an informal yet co-ordinated response. The voluntary nature of the assistance provided, together with the overview provided by Council staff, preclude any liability attaching to SHMRG members.

#### **ACTIVATION AND TRIGGER LEVELS**

SHMRG leaders will be contacted by telephone and requested to initiate monitoring activities when one of the following specified flood warning trigger levels is reached:

Manawatu River
Oroua River
50 year return period flood,
20 year return period flood,

• Minor tributaries (Linton Main Drain, Tokomaru River, Mangaone Stream, Kara Creek, Mangapukatea Stream, Makino Stream).

• Localised heavy rainfall may dictate an earlier trigger level.

#### **RESOURCES**

It is intended that each sub-group will generally be self-sufficient however, requests for additional assistance with manpower, machinery or materials will be considered by the EOC in relation to the demands of the wider emergency.

HRC will not accept responsibility for any costs incurred for the purchase of materials or hire of machinery where prior approval has not been given.

#### **USE OF MATERIALS**

Depots have been established at key locations throughout the scheme area, for the storage of sand and bags. It is expected that team leaders will be familiar with depot locations and will have direct access to those without assistance from Horizons Regional Council staff. The materials stockpiled at these depots are only to be used in an emergency. Horizons regularly inspect and maintain the materials at these depots. The five depots currently established are shown on the map overleaf and in the table below:

#### **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

Members of the SHMRG will not be working under Horizons supervision and will therefore at all times be responsible for making their own assessments of hazards and managing their own personal safety, just as they would when working on their own farms.



#### COMMUNICATIONS

Activation of the SHMRG will be by telephone call to team leaders from the EOC. Group leaders can also initiate contact with the EOC by calling the Horizons Call Centre, **0508 800 800**, asking for the "EOC Operations Manager" and identifying themselves as a SHMRG Group Leader.

On initial contact with the Operations Manager, a dedicated phone contact number may then be allocated.


The SHMRG has an important part to play in a major emergency response and as such is an officially recognised group within the EOC.

#### **GROUP MEETINGS/PLAN REVIEWS**

The Area Engineer is required to convene meetings of the SHMRG at intervals not exceeding two years. Matters to be discussed shall include:


Updating membership and contact details for the respective groups; Reviewing operational procedures; and Recognising Council's appreciation for the voluntary participation of group members.


The Operational Plan shall be reviewed to reflect any damages arising from the meetings and revised copies shall be forwarded to all current SHMRG members.




LOCATION OF MATERIALS FOR FLOOD DAMAGE CONTROL
