Good Morning,

The italicised section of this email is advice from the Commissioners regarding the Applicants Right of Reply.

The Commissioners have conferred about all the further information now provided about the Pahiatua WWTP. We very much apologise for having overlooked this previously.

We have reviewed all this new information, and we see no need to re-convene the Pahiatua WWTP hearing. Nor do we see a need to commission a Cultural Values Assessment at this stage of the process.

The applicant can now finalise their right of reply. Once we have received this the hearing will be closed and our decision will be issued. In the circumstances we can hardly ask for the right of reply promptly, but it would be good if it were provided soon as that may enable us to issue our decision before the Christmas break.

In their right of reply the applicant should update us on any further discussions with Rangitane or Kahungunu, and address the matter raised by Morry Black in his letter dated 7 August about notification of any additional consents sought during this process. The applicant can of course also respond to any other issues, including differences between condition sets from themselves and the officers, in that right of reply.

At this stage of the process the only party who can provide us further information is the applicant.
