Entry and Release Agreement

Terms and Conditions

- Entry into the film competition is free.
- The film competition is open to ALL Manawatu Early Childhood Centres and Schools.
- Schools/ECE centres may enter only one film per category (up to four entries each).
- Films must be accompanied by a completed and signed entry form.
- Entries can be submitted by uploading the film to YouTube and emailing the link and the completed entry form to education@horizons.govt.nz. Alternatively, save both the entry form and the film onto a USB drive and post/drop in to Horizons Regional Council, 11 Victoria Ave, Palmerston North – Attn: Rowena Brown.
- Prizes will be awarded for the best in each category, as per the judging criteria.
- Prizes will be awarded to the school/centre, not to individual students.
- Written consent is needed from parents or legal guardian(s) for students under the age of 18 years, appearing in the film.
- Films should be no longer than 4 minutes in length.
- Competition will run from 7 August 2017 to 9 October 2017 at 5pm.
- A screening of winning films and a prize giving will be held at Manawatu District Council in the week beginning 30 October 2017.
- Winning entries will be contacted by Friday 20 October.
