



Don Linklater Memorial Bursary 2025

Application Form

To honour the contribution made to the Manawatū-Whanganui Region and to local government by the late Don Linklater, Horizons Regional Council Chairman 1989-2000, we are offering a bursary for university study.

The bursary is worth \$8,000 per year, distributed across up to four recipients, and aims to support students studying in areas relevant to Horizons' work.

To be eligible you must:

(please read this section carefully)

- be studying, or planning to study, at a New Zealand university fulltime in 2025 at either undergraduate or postgraduate level (internally, extramurally) in one of the existing fields:
 - Resource Management
 - Environmental Planning
 - Environmental Engineering with particular emphasis on river and drainage basin dynamics
- be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident and live in the Horizons region (although you may be studying elsewhere in New Zealand).

How is the bursary awarded?

The bursary recipients will be selected by a panel of Horizons' representatives. Up to four recipients may be successful. Consideration will be made to at least one of the four bursaries, based on meeting the eligibility criteria and your iwi/hapū connections to the region. Shortlisted applicants will then meet with the selection panel.

What you need to do to apply:

If you meet the eligibility criteria and would like to apply for a bursary, please complete this form and attach:

- verified copies of your most recent academic qualifications. If you have not yet completed a term of university study, please attach your previous two years' high school academic records. If you have already completed some tertiary study please attach academic transcripts for study completed to date;
- an essay, of no more than 300 words, telling us why you should receive this bursary, and what you intend to do as a result of your study that will benefit our region and environment; and
- a copy of your CV (optional).

Applications must be received by Sunday 30 March 2025.



Bursary Conditions

Applications for the Don Linklater Memorial Bursary are sought annually. The bursary will be awarded, subject to funding, and providing applications are of sufficient merit.

A bursary will be awarded to the successful candidate under the following conditions:

- a total of \$8,000 per year is available to be distributed. Successful applicants (up to 4) will be paid their part in two installments, one payment in June/July and one in December;
- consideration will be made to at least one of the four bursaries based on meeting the eligibility criteria and your iwi/hapū connections to the region. If you are applying based on this criteria, please complete as indicated in the section below;
- proof of satisfactory academic progress must be provided to Horizons following completion of each semester, payment will be made following receipt of the satisfactory results;
- bursary recipients are required to apply for the Linklater Bursary at the beginning of each academic year for approval, including current recipients;
- bursary recipients, who, without good reason, withdraw from fulltime study or fail to successfully complete papers, may be required to reimburse all or part of the bursary to Horizons.
