MAY IT PLEASE THE HEARINGS COMMISSIONER

- [1] This Joint Memorandum is filed to provide further reporting on behalf of Manawatū-Whanganui Regional Council (MWRC) and Horowhenua District Council (HDC), on matters directed in Minute 4 of the Independent Hearing Panel dated 1 May 2021.
- [2] As signalled in the last memorandum filed by counsel for MWRC, and following discussions between the parties, a further section 92 request was issued to HDC on 5 May 2021. The parties met on 11 May 2021, with technical experts from both sides, and have agreed a way forward with respect to a response to the section 92 request, including expert conferencing on specific matters and proposed timeframes.

Proposed timeline

- [3] Counsel respectfully propose the following timeline, pursuant to s 103B of the RMA:
 - (a) HDC to respond to MWRC's further section 92 request by 2 July 2021, to allow time for expert conferencing or similar (in respect of methodology for obtaining the further information requested) to occur and for HDC to provide comprehensive responses to MWRC's further s 92 request.
 - (b) If any procedural issues relating to scope of the application and/or notification are identified as a result of HDC's response to MWRC's further s 92 request, these are to be raised with the Hearings Commissioner by 16 July 2021. It is noted that if any such issues are identified, further timetabling amendments may be required.
 - (c) MWRC are to file and circulate an updated section 42A report, along with any other accompanying reports, by 1:00 PM on **23 July 2021**.
 - (d) HDC are to file and circulate any briefs of evidence by 1:00 PM on 30July 2021.

- (e) Any submitters wishing to call expert evidence are to file and circulate a written statement of that evidence by 1:00 PM on 6 August 2021, with submitters wishing to file written submissions themselves, or have non-expert persons to appear on their behalf, strongly urged to provide written statements of that evidence also by that date.
- (f) If MWRC, HDC, or any submitter propose to have legal counsel present legal submissions, these are to be filed by 1:00 PM on 12 August 2021.
- (g) The hearing to be held on an appropriate date during, or from, the week commencing **16 August 2021**.
