4 **Project update**

A brief project update was provided by Staci. Progress on the wetland design was described and an update on the consenting timeframes was provided. Proposed timeframe for input into the design will likely be late March.

Phil offered to support with information during the consenting process.

Jay asked if we are considering nutrients and bacteria from non –native birds within the lake.

Roger raised concerns around costs and efficiency of funding. He suggested intervention options for clearing out the sediment from the area next to the weir in the lake and dredging that had been used in the past.

Jay highlighted that the project ensured vegetable production could continue in the catchment and that more money will be required in the future to fulfill the community vision. There were some concerns about the project potentially running over budget and the project team were asked to share budgets.

6 Values

The current project objectives in addition to a proposed outcomes, values and guiding concepts as provided by HortNZ were circulated ahead of the meeting as a starting point for the discussion around the Community Stakeholder Group's values for the project.

Key themes raised by the group were visibility, transparency and communication. Other values and considerations put forward included

- Public engagement
- Balance of land uses
- Enduring community asset
- Being outcomes focused (sampling/testing the lake)
- Incorporating race course drain in design
- Considering on land activities changes on farm
- Other lake outputs measuring other sources of pollution and sharing data
- Wellbeing measures

- Local snail may be able to have a new habitat
- Freshwater improvements
- Preserve food production
- Reciprocity
