LOWER MANAWATU SCHEME (LMS) - RIVER MANAGEMENT UPDATE

This item informed Members of the Lower Manawatu Scheme management issues that may have some impact on the recreational use of the river. Ms Buchanan (Engineering Officer Central) took Members through the report, provided further information where relevant, and responded to Members' questions.

There was discussion about possible sightings of Alligator Weed in the Manawatu Estuary and Old Man's Beard in the city area, and the New Zealand Transport Agency Waka Kotahi position around a decision to retain or remove the old river bridge at Whirikino.
