

Key Statistics: Estimated Reach of Proposed One Plan Consultation Tools

In the past 5 years (up until May 2008) there has been:

- 1 *Proposed One Plan* notified
- 2 *Summary of Submissions* documents prepared for the Proposed Plan
- 3 versions of the One Plan website at www.horizons.govt.nz
- 4 *Roadmap Summary Guides* on the Plan's development issued and 4 "iterative" Working Drafts of the One Plan.
- 5 One Plan stakeholder newsletters circulated
- 7 regional hui held with various iwi authorities
- 8 information sheets issued on the impacts of the Proposed One Plan on resource user groups
- 10 towns across the region visited in the 2005 "*Picture our Environment*" consultation roadshow
- 35 public meetings held on the One Plan
- 37 One Plan update circulated via the Council's meeting agendas
- 63 Horizons press releases issued on the One Plan and related aspects
- 170 stakeholders who received Version 4 of the iterative Working Draft of the One Plan
- ≈ 200 visitors to the 2006 LTCCP/One Plan Feedback Roadshow
- 212 stakeholder meetings held on the One Plan
- 467 submissions received on the Proposed One Plan and 62 further submissions
- 703 interested parties signed up to the current One Plan mailing list
- 1134 press articles on the One Plan and related aspects
- 1500 visitors to Horizons Central Districts Field Days stand (including One Plan information) each year (2005-2008)
- 1530 internet records regarding the One Plan accumulated online (measured via a Google search)
- 3786 visitors voted on environmental issues in the "*Picture our Environment*" roadshow
- 26 000 visitors exposed to the "BIG 4" issues via the Green RIG (2007/2008 financial year)
- ≈ 60 000 One Plan 'page views' on the horizons website (2004-2008)
- ≈ 100 000 ratepayers (dwellings) who have received copies of the *Across the Region* circular containing One Plan information (up to three times a year) and also the Proposed Plan notification flyer in 2008.
