The Horowhenua District Council opposes the submission of Beef + Lamb. A 'one size fits all' regulatory approach for intensive landuse activities isn't supported, particularly for target catchments in the Horowhenua district. The target catchments in Horowhenua are characterised by diverse land use activities and primary production systems, nutrient management profiles and environmental effects. In the absence of a robust catchment-wide approach to nutrient management and orderly transition planning in the Horowhenua target catchments and buy-in from landowners and key stakeholders, Plan Change 2 will not achieve the objectives of integrated resource management and fulfil the principles and purposes of the

Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA) . Further stakeholder engagement with key stakeholders prior to notification was scant and is now imperative, before final decisions are made, to ensure that multiple perspectives are heard and responded to, in accordance with Schedule 1 of the RMA. The Horowhenua District Council submits that a collaborative planning approach with all stakeholders would be a better alternative, and most likely to deliver a long lasting, enduring transition plan for intensive land use activities in the target catchments in Horowhenua.
