



HOW ARE THESE SERVICES FUNDED?

Subsidised bus services operating across the region are funded through a number of sources, including fares from passengers, local targeted rates (of the district in which the service operates) and central government subsidy. When more passengers use the service, more revenue is collected from fares, which means less funding is needed from local rates. See the diagrams below to show how the number of passengers changes the burden on ratepayers. A service that is well utilised provides transport opportunities for residents and benefits the wider community.
