



Hochstetter's Frog

Instructions

Draw a line from the word to the matching part on the frog's body.

Distinctive lumpy skin with many little warts

Semipermeable skin that must stay damp so they can breathe

Males have more muscular forelimbs than females

Tail wagging muscles, retained after metamorphosis

No middle ear or external eardrum

No vocal sac, *Leiopelma* frogs cannot croak like other frogs

White toe-tips

Partial webbing on back feet

Large round pupils, specially adapted to see at night

White stripes below each nostril
